## New Enhancement for R6V06

A new option has been added to **Location Tax** to indicate whether sales taxes are applicable to non-labor or labor charges posted to a work order.

On the Edit Tax Code window (Figure 1), different Tax 1 and Tax 2 codes can be assigned separately for Non-Labor and Labor entries. For Tax 3 and Tax 4, these must continue to be globally assigned to a work order but now the user can indicate, via a check box, if the Tax 3 and Tax 4 codes apply to labor. In the example given, Tax 3 will apply but Tax 4 will not apply to labor posted to work orders created for this location.

In this example work order (Figure 2), the tax codes default to those loaded in the Location Tax Configuration.

The Parts & Labor Billed window (Figure 3) shows a labor transaction posted to the work order where the tax rules defined in the Location Tax Configuration were followed.
